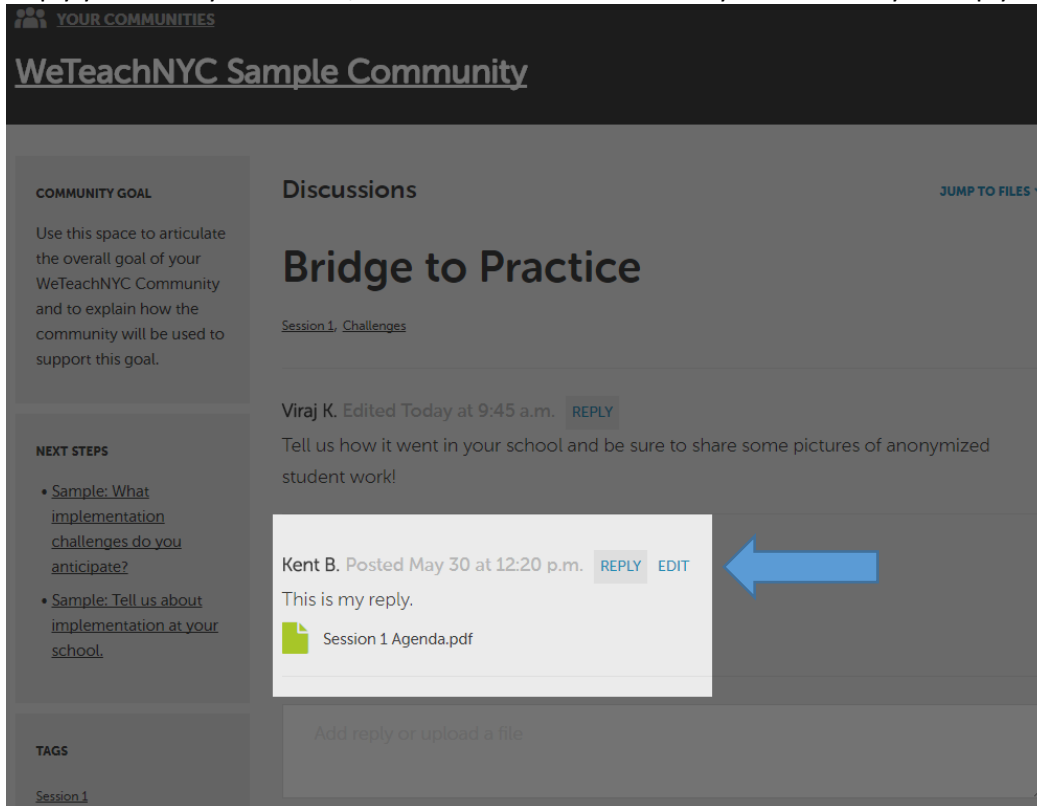


Editing Discussion Replies
